

2024 CHRISTMAS MESSAGE

"For unto us a child is born" (Isaiah 9:6)

Dear friends,

2000 years ago, the angels heralded the good news that Christ, the savior of the human race was born from the Virgin Mary in Bethlehem. Christ came to restore our lost dignity and friendship with God our heavenly father. Every Christmas gives us an opportunity to relive the incredible miracle of the first Christmas when the word became flesh and dwelt among us (John 1:14). The Christmas liturgy recalls how God left the highest heavens to dwell among us in human flesh through the womb of the Blessed Virgin Mary. He was born in a stable among the sheep, born in poverty in order to save us from sin and death. We rejoice in this incarnation every day of our lives because it is the apex of divine love for mankind. "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16). As you approach the crib chanting, "o come let us adore him," I pray that the love and peace that comes from the baby in the manger will abide in your hearts, homes and families. There are many families that are fighting and are torn apart. Many families will not be sitting around the dinner table to celebrate this most wonderful time of the year because of family feuds.

May this season of Christmas be a time of peace, love and reconciliation in every family. May families spend Christmas united in front of the crib with their gaze fixed on Christ the prince of peace.

On July 25, we shall attend the Bicentenary celebration of Blessed Luigi Monti, founder of the Congregation of the Sons of the Immaculate Conception. From Milan we will drive to Mount Rigi, Switzerland and enjoy panoramic views of the Swiss Alps and surrounding lakes. Then we shall drive to France and visit the Eiffel Tower and take a Seine River Cruise to see Paris. On July 30th we will fly back to Toronto. The Catholic Church worldwide is celebrating a special Jubilee Year in 2025. The theme of the 2025 Jubilee is "Pilgrims of Hope". In the words of Pope Francis: "We must fan the flame of hope that has been given us, and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart and far-sighted vision." The Holy Father opened the Jubilee Year on December 24, 2024, with the official opening of the Holy Door of Saint Peter's Basilica and continuing until January 6, 2026, the Solemnity of the Epiphany, with the closing of the Holv Door. In the Archdiocese of Toronto, we will open the Jubilee Year with a Solemn **Opening Mass taking place on Sunday,** December 29, 2024, at 5:00 p.m. at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica. All are invited to join in this special celebration. Please note that the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be available prior to the Eucharist from 3:30 p.m. to 4:45 p.m. May this Holy Year provide a grace-filled opportunity to nurture the seeds of faith for you and your loved ones, immersing ourselves as Pilgrims of Hope into a yearlong journey of prayer, witness and service drawing on the example of Jesus, our Lord.
