

PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD APRIL 13, 2025



From the Pastor's Desk

PALM SUNDAY

Beloved in Christ, together with the universal Church, we celebrate Palm Sunday, also known as Passion Sunday, marking the beginning of the holiest week in the Christian liturgical calendar. The name Palm Sunday is derived from the palm branches we bless and carry in procession to commemorate the triumphant entry of Jesus into the holy city of Jerusalem, where He would be sacrificed as the Paschal Lamb for our salvation. It is also called Passion Sunday because the Passion narrative is proclaimed. Today's celebration begins with a jubilant crowd welcoming Jesus, chanting: "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" (Lk 19:38). Yet, just a few days later, the same crowd would turn against Him, shouting in hostility: "Crucify him! Crucify him!" (Lk 23:21). Why? Because He did not meet their expectations of a king. They could not comprehend a king who rides on a donkey... a king who chooses the cross for His throne... a king who promises not earthly comfort, but eternal joy in heaven.

THE EASTER TRIDUUM

The Easter Triduum begins on **Holy Thursday** evening with the Mass of the Lord's Supper, where we commemorate the institution of the Eucharist, Holy Orders and the commandment to love and serve one another. In loving others, we make Christ present among us.

Good Friday: On this day we mark the Passion of the Lord — a solemn day when Christ is condemned and crucified like a criminal on the Cross of Calvary. The liturgy will consist of three parts: the proclamation of the Passion; the veneration of the Cross, and the reception of Holy Communion. As is tradition in our parish, there will be a **reenactment of the Passion at 5:00pm**, to which all are invited to attend.

Easter Vigil: The Easter Vigil is the high point of the Triduum and of our entire liturgical year. On this most holy night, we sing Alleluia once more because Christ is truly risen, just as He said. At the heart of our Christian faith is this proclamation: "Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep" (1 Cor 15:20). As St. Paul affirms, "If Christ has not been

raised, your faith is in vain" (1 COT 15:17). The vigil includes the lighting of the Easter Candle, the singing of the *Exultet*, Baptism and Confirmation of adults, and First Holy Communion for the newly initiated.



Easter Sunday continues the celebration of the Resurrection of the Lord. We rejoice and proclaim: Jesus Christ is risen today! Alleluia! He has conquered sin and triumphed over death. On this day, the Gloria and Alleluia return to our liturgy, as we sing with joy and thanksgiving.

THOU SHALT NOT EAT MEAT!

Did you know that Catholics aged fourteen and older are required to **abstain from meat** on days of penance, such as Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays of Lent? This practice honours Christ who sacrificed His flesh for us on Good Friday. Abstinence is a form of penance and an expression of sorrow for our sins. It signifies our desire to repent, to avoid situations that lead us into sin, and to turn back to God with our whole hearts.

At Immaculate Conception Parish, it is customary for parishioners to generously donate for the purchase of flowers to decorate our church for Easter.
