

# From the Pastor's Desk

#### Dear parishioners,

Today we celebrate the feast of the Holy Family of Nazareth, that is, the Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. We also celebrate the feast of all families because the Holy Family is the patron and model of all Christian families. This feast shows us that God chose to be born in a family in order to consecrate and sanctify the family. Jesus grew up in a family and his parents taught him Jewish laws and customs within the family. In today's gospel, Saint Luke tells us that when Jesus was twelve years old, his parents brought him to the temple to participate in the annual celebration of the Jewish feast of Passover (Luke 2,41-52). The gospel shows us very clearly the educative aspect of the family. The second Vatican council describes the family as the domestic church (LG #11). This means that it is in the context of the family that we first learn who God is and to prayerfully seek His will for us. The family is the locus par *excellence* where we learn to pray, to love, to forgive and to respect people and differences. The purpose of this feast within the Octave of Christmas is to encourage every family to model their lives on the example of the Holy Family. There is no doubt that no family can be as perfect and holy as the Holy Family, but every family must strive to become a holy family. In the Holy Family, the child Jesus was obedient to his parents; He went down to Nazareth with them and was obedient (Lc 2,51). He never gave them attitude, never answered back and did his chores. Therefore, children, I exhort you to honour your father and mother (Ex 20:12). In the Holy Family, Joseph, the father and husband, was a provider and protector of his family. He worked as a carpenter to put food on the table for his family and put a roof over their heads. As a protector, he escaped with his family to Egypt when Herod wanted to kill the child (Matt. 2:13-23). Therefore, I exhort all fathers to be providers and protectors of their family. In the Holy family, the Blessed Mother was a caring, nurturing, prayerful and faithful mother and wife. Therefore, I exhort all mothers and wives to be caring and nurturing and pray for their families. Always remember that family is gold. There is

no perfect family. Therefore, love and cherish your family and create memories with your family that will last a lifetime. May God bless all families.
