

From the Pastor's Desk... 2024 Lenten Message

"Return to me with all your heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning" (Joel 2:12).

Dear Parishioners,

On Wednesday February 14 the Universal Church will celebrate Ash Wednesday, which marks the beginning of Lent. Lent in the Christian liturgical calendar is a time of preparation for the celebration of the Paschal Mystery, that is, the passion, death and glorious resurrection of Christ at Easter. The holy season of lent is a favourable time for a pilgrimage towards the Paschal Vigil when Christ the paschal lamb "dispels all evil, washes guilt away, restores lost innocence, brings mourners joy, casts out hatred, brings us peace and humbles earthly pride" (Paschal Præconium).

The church invites us during these forty days to pause from the busyness of everyday life and follow Jesus "into the wilderness" to pray, fast and renew ourselves through a radical conversion. The gospels tell us that immediately after his baptism by John, the spirit led Jesus into the wilderness where he stayed forty days without eating; he lived among wild beasts, and angels ministered to him. At the end, Satan tempts him three times. Jesus rebuffs these attacks and humiliates Satan who left until an opportune time (CCC).

Jesus teaches us to be courageous in facing our own wildernesses, and through intense prayer and fasting, resist the lures and enticements of the devil. I urge you to be watchful and vigilant against the enticements of Satan that may appear under the guise of good. Satan is a shrewd and cunning being who masters the art of deceit and manipulation. The Bible refers to him as "the deceiver of the whole world..." (Rev. 12:9). He can easily trick us if we give him the least opportunity. St James says, "resist the devil, and he will flee from you" (4:7). The best way to resist the devil is to be devoted to daily prayer, Lectio Divina, recourse to the sacrament of Reconciliation and above all, participate in the celebration of the Holy Eucharist, the source and summit of the Christian life.

To this end, I invoke the intercession of Blessed Luigi Maria Monti and the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church, to accompany us on our Lenten journey.
