

From the Pastor's Desk

THE WEDDING FEAST AT CANA

Dear friends, welcome back to Ordinary Time. Today, we celebrate the second Sunday in Ordinary Time and the liturgy invites us to reflect on the wedding feast at Cana as narrated by John, who personally witnessed the event. Jesus was at a wedding feast at Cana and they ran out of wine. A wedding is a joyful celebration of love with lots of food. drinks entertainment. and good music. Unfortunately, at the wedding feast at Cana, there was a shortage of wine, which was a huge embarrassment for the couple. Mary, the Mother of Jesus, recognizes the problem and immediately brings it to the attention of her Son saying, "They have no wine." Mary does not tell Jesus how to fix the problem. She simply articulates the need at hand while trusting that her son will do something. Then she says to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you" (John 2:5). This gospel narrative tells us that Jesus responded to his mother's plea with a generous gift of the finest wine. He transformed water into wine and brought so much joy and happiness to the wedding couple and their guests. The new wine was so much better than the previous one that the people remarked: "Everyone serves good wine first, and then when people have drunk freely, an inferior one; but you have kept the good wine until now." This is the first miracle of Jesus and it took place at a wedding feast to show that God gives much importance to the institution of marriage. Jesus was present at the wedding ceremony and he brought great blessings and joy to the newlywed couple by saving them from a huge embarrassment when they ran out of wine. Jesus is also seen here as the Messiah who shows love and mercy to his people especially in their time of need. Lastly, today's gospel reminds us of the vital intercessory role of Mary beside her Son in heaven. When we are in need, we can get to Jesus through Mary who is the mediatrix par excellence. Whatever your needs, whatever challenges you may face, whatever obstacles you may encounter, I invite you to turn to Jesus through Mary. Maybe you are battling with some health challenges, a broken family, a difficult child at home, the pain of childlessness, I urge you to bring that situation to the Blessed Mother and she will present it to her Son Jesus. Mary is our Mother and she cares about our wellbeing and happiness.
