

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process through which interested unbaptized adults and older children (catechumens) are introduced to the Roman Catholic faith and become members of the Catholic Church. The RCIA program is a time of reflection, prayer, study, and discernment leading to the celebration of becoming full members at the Easter Vigil.
