

From the Pastor's Desk


THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

Today, we celebrate the Third Sunday of Lent, and in the Gospel. Jesus invites his disciples to repent or perish. Interrogators recount two stories of human tragedy, and Jesus uses these as an opportunity to emphasize the urgency of his message of repentance. The first incident involves the ruthless slaughter of Galilean pilgrims who went to the temple in Jerusalem to offer sacrifices and were mercilessly killed by the troops of Pilate, the Roman governor (cf. Lk 13:1). The second is the sudden death of 18 people when the tower of Siloam in Jerusalem collapsed (cf. Lk 13:4). At that time, the Jews often interpreted such misfortunes as a direct consequence of sin, believing that those who suffered tragedies were being punished by God. Meanwhile, those who considered themselves "sinless and righteous" assumed they were immune to suffering and saw no need for repentance. Jesus challenges this misguided belief. He asks, "Do you think that these Galileans who were murdered were worse sinners than all the other Galileans? I tell you, no; but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish" (Lk 13:2-3). Through this, Jesus reminds us that unexpected tragedies can befall both the righteous and the unrighteous, often without warning, leaving no time for repentance. Therefore, he urges his listeners to repent without delay. As we journey through this sacred and transformative season of Lent, each one of us is called to a radical conversion — to turn away from sin and align our lives with the values of the Gospel. Repentance cannot be postponed. Procrastination and spiritual complacency are dangerous because tomorrow is never guaranteed. Let us seize the opportunity today to walk in the light of God, renewing our hearts and minds. May we open ourselves to His mercy and forgiveness, knowing that the time for repentance is now.
