

### Be a Witness to the Gospel

Dear friends, today we celebrate the solemnity of Pentecost. Prior to his Ascension into Heaven, Jesus ordered his disciples "not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father" (cf. Acts 1: 4-5), and they gathered in prayer with Mary in the Upper Room, awaiting the promised event (cf. Acts 1: 14). Today, Jesus fulfils that promise to send the Holy Spirit, who as wind and as fire descended upon the Apostles and enabled them to preach the Gospel to all nations with courage (cf. Acts 2: 1-13). As Christians we also received the Holy Spirit on the day of our baptism and confirmation. We were commissioned and sent to bear witness to the gospel by our words and by our actions. Therefore, let your life be a reflection of the love of Jesus Christ because your life may be the only bible some people can read. "Life is God's gift to you....the way you live your life is your gift to God."

## Archbishop Leo Promoting a Culture of life

Archbishop Leo of Toronto has urged Christians to pray for the sanctity of life during the month of May. In his message for Life on May 11, 2023 the archbishop reminded us of our call to build the Kingdom of Christ, which includes publicly affirming the sacredness of life from the moment of conception to natural death. He regretted that in contemporary culture access to abortion and euthanasia often rests on the false assumption that life is a disposable commodity that can be done away with when it is inconvenient. The Month of May is an ideal time for us to turn to Mother Mary, the woman and mother who said Yes to the Lord, the Giver of life and conceived the Son of God but who likewise remained with and accompanied the Lord Jesus to the very end; she is an example for us. Let us pray for new mothers and families, those struggling with an unplanned pregnancy and for those who have experienced the pain and anguish of abortion.
