



# PRAYING FOR THE SOULS OF THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED IN THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

Are you mourning the death of a loved one? Are you wondering whether the soul of your loved one is in heaven or in a state of purification in purgatory? According to the rich tradition of the Catholic Church, during the entire month of November we remember and pray for our deceased family members, friends, parishioners and all the dead. Through intercessory prayers, alms, lighting of votive candles, visits to the cemeteries, and Holy Mass, we pray that they may be purified and cleansed from all stain of sin and welcomed into heaven. As Archbishop Francis Leo states, "Indeed, holy Mother Church recommends and encourages that we intercede for the eternal salvation of the faithful departed during the entire month of November. Praying for the deceased should never be seen as something morbid, or as a failure to "move on" with our own life from the death of a loved one. When we pray for those who have passed away before us, we contemplate the mystery of the Death and Resurrection of Christ; we acknowledge with personal and ecclesial faith that for Christ's faithful "life is changed not ended, and, when this earthly dwelling turns to dust, an eternal dwelling is made ready for them in heaven" (Preface I For the Dead, The Roman Missal, 2011); and finally, as members of the communion of saints, we petition the Lord for mercy and forgiveness on behalf of those who have died in the peace of Christ" (Message for All Souls Day - 2 November 2024).



Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let Your perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed rest in peace.
