

OCTOBER IS THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY



Do you have a rosary? How often do you pray the Holy Rosary? For us Catholics, the month of October is often dedicated to the Holy Rosary. The church invites us to pray the Holy Rosary throughout this month of October, enabling us to contemplate the important moments of our salvation from the life of Jesus Christ, his passion, death and glorious resurrection and ascension into heavenly glory. Of course, we also meditate on the Blessed Virgin Mary and the important role she played in the history of our salvation through her humble fiat - I am the servant of the Lord, let it be done to me according to your will. In her various apparitions, the Blessed Mother encouraged God's children to recite the rosary constantly. As Archbishop Francis Leo of Toronto contends, 90 years ago in Fatima, the Blessed Mother "presenting herself as "Our Lady of the Rosary", insistently recommended the daily recitation of the Rosary to the three little shepherd children, Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco, in order to obtain the end of the war. Let us also accept the Virgin's motherly request, pledging to recite the Rosary with faith for peace in families, nations and throughout world."

DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that a Jubilee Year occurs every 25 years in the Catholic Church? In 2025, we will be celebrating the Jubilee and the theme chosen is "Pilgrims of Hope!" It will be a year of hope for a world that is heavily impacted by wars, climate change, and the ongoing effects of Covid-19. To prepare for this, Pope Francis has called for a "Year of Prayer." According to the Holy Father, it will be a year dedicated "to rediscovering the great value and absolute need for prayer; prayer in personal life, in the life of the Church, prayer in the world."
