

FEAST OF BLESSED LUIGI MONTI

Today, we celebrate the feast day of Blessed Luigi Maria Monti, founder of the Congregation of the Sons of the Immaculate Conception. This feast is not just a sentimental commemoration of the life of a man who gave eloquent witness to the gospel of Christ by loving and serving the poor, the sick and the orphaned. It is also a reminder to focus our gaze on Fr. Monti's spirituality and through his intercession ask the Lord for the special grace to imitate his heroic virtues in order to be "perfect as your heavenly father is perfect" (Matt 5:48).
